

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 a.m. at the county road shop as advertised. Present were Commissioners Stout, May & Craven. Also present were Darrell Olson, road foreman, J. Kinney, L. Schmitz, T. Stahl, W. Reynolds & M Turpin. Road matters were discussed. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 a.m.

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. as advertised. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stout at 9:00 a.m. Roll call was taken. Present were Stout, Craven & May. Also present was W. Hollenbeck, Commissioner Candidate & D Buoy, County Clerk.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion made by Craven and seconded by May to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk's office. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.

The minutes of the August 4, 2020 meeting were presented. Motion by May and seconded by Craven to approve the minutes as presented. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.

Stout stated the Open Meeting Law is posted on the wall in the Commissioner's room.

Commissioners decided not to forward contract Propane this year.

Commissioners reviewed the Jail Standards Report from the State of Nebraska. The jail is in full compliance.

Update on Carn's Bridge was received. The State of Nebraska is waiting on results of Hydrology Study from Miller & Assoc. This study has been completed.

J. Anderson, Sheriff met with Commissioners on State Patrol shutting down NCIC to counties on 9/21/20. Region 26 has agreed to provide this service for \$1200/year. Anderson also informed Commissioners that Deb Fox was retiring. Anderson stated he hired Kelcy Funke for a 32 hour week at \$21.50/hr.

Motion by Stout and seconded by Craven to approve Application for Tax exempt for the Senior Center Car. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.

Motion by Stout and seconded by Craven to approve Resolution 2020-12 to transfer \$200,000 for BKR Bridge Fund to the Road Fund to be paid back when funds are available. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.

G. May returned to the meeting at 10:30 a.m. C. Johnson & D. Buoy met with the Commissioners to discuss 20/21 Budget. Motion by Stout and seconded by Craven to approve Resolution 2020-13 approving RC Airport \$7120; RC Ag Society \$29,651.40; Gracy Rural Fire Dept. \$10536.99; Newport Rural Fire Dept. \$20895.04 & Rock County Rural Fire Dept. \$75,425.65 totaling \$150,828.48 tax allocation to Misc. Districts. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.

A. Gurnsey met with the Commissioners on Tort claim. Motion by Craven and seconded by Stout to go into Executive Session at 1:05 p.m. to discuss Correspondence from F. Taylor related to Tort Claim. Motion by Stout and seconded by May to come out of Executive Session at 1:14 p.m. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.

Motion by May and seconded by Craven to approve 2020 Inventories as presented. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.

Motion by Stout and seconded by May to approve Clerk Buoy to sign bond purchase agreement. Roll call vote: All in favor None opposed. Motion carried.
