The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at the Springview Courthouse for a 2:00 p.m. joint meeting with Region 24 Members to discuss Region 24 Issues and Resolutions. The meeting was a 2:00 p.m. agenda item for the Keya Paha County Commissioners. Present were: Corey Nilson, Mike Tuerk & Bruce Ritterbush, Keya Paha County Commissioners; Jim Stout, Wade Hollenbeck & Glen May, Rock County Commissioners, May is also Deputy Emergency Manager for Rock County; Martin DeNayer & James Ward in person & Tanya Storer via cell phone, Cherry County Commissioners; Buddy Small, Brown County Commissioner, Andrew Taylor, Brown County Attorney & Bruce Papstein, Brown County Sheriff; Alan Nicolaus & Ronald Bernt, Boyd County Commissioners along with other interested individuals. Scott began by stating that the reason for the meeting between the counties comprising Region 24 was to determine if it is feasible to continue. Brown County and Cherry County have both filed notices that they will withdraw from Region 24 effective June 30th 2021. Representatives of both counties affirmed that decision, stating they are not interested in being involved with Region 24 even if it is restructured. The conclusion after discussion, is that Region 24 cannot continue in its current form.
