

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 a.m. at the county road shop as advertised. Present were Commissioners Stout & May Absent Hollenbeck. Road employees were: D. Olson, road foreman, J. Kinney, T. Stahl & M. Turpin. Road matters were discussed. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 a.m.

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. as advertised. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stout at 9:00 a.m. Roll call was taken. Present were Stout, Hollenbeck & May. Also present were D. Olson, Road Foreman & D. Buoy, County Clerk.

The minutes of the May 4, 2021 regular meeting were presented. Motion made by May and seconded by Hollenbeck to approve the minutes as presented. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against Motion carried.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion made by Hollenbeck and seconded by May to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk's office. Roll call vote: All For None Against Motion carried.

Stout stated the Open Meeting Law is posted on the wall in the Commissioner's room.

D. Olson, Road Foreman met with the Commissioners on Road Department updates. Motion by Stout and seconded by May to have Olson advertise for quotes for trucking & machine hire. Roll call vote: All For None Against Motion carried. Surplus equipment was discussed. Motion by May and seconded by Hollenbeck to list the surplus equipment on Big Iron the 1994 Ford F150. Roll call vote: All For None Against Motion carried.

C. Magary resigned her part time position as custodian. One application was received for the part time custodial position. Motion by May and seconded by Hollenbeck to approve C. Painter's application for part time custodian at \$15.00 per hour. Roll call vote: All For None Against Motion carried.

M. Davis met with the Commissioners on the Road Fund Bond. There is not enough in that fund to pay for the payment in July due to tax collections being down.

Commissioners received correspondence from the Nebraska Tax Equalization and Review Commissioner. Valuation for the class or subclass of real property in Rock County for the tax year 2021 requires no adjustments.

Hours worked to qualify for health insurance or insurance reimbursement was discussed. L. Friedrich, Deputy Treasurer was also present. 30 hours per week is the requirement to receive this benefit now. Motion by May and seconded by Hollenbeck to approve 30 hours. Roll call vote: All For None Against Motion carried.

M. Dean met with the Commissioners on noxious weed matters. Spurge & Purple Loosestrife was discussed. The Commissioners are encouraging land owners to address the spraying of noxious weeds. It is the Law.

A. Grant met with the Commissioners on trainings requested by NIRMA (the Counties Insurance Co.) Rock County has scheduled for May 26th a training for Active Shooter & Riot/Protest Response.

T. Ellermeier, Assessor met with the Commissioners on Oblique photos. Matter tabled.

J. Anderson, Sheriff; M. Davis, Treasurer; D. Buoy, Clerk & D. Fox, Emergency Manager met with the Commissioners on the direction of Rock County's E911. E911 money has to remain in the designated funds until the 20/21 Federal audit is finished.
