**RESOLUTION TO CLOSE THE HOSPITAL GOB SOFTWARE BOND FUND
ALSO KNOWN AS THE CLINIC/SOFTWARE BOND FUND**

WHEREAS: The Rock County Board of Commissioners has adopted the Amended 2020-2021 Budget of Rock County Nebraska which had provisions for the transfer of up to \$39.04 from the Hospital GOB Software Bond Fund (Clinic/Software Bond Fund) to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS: Upon review of the resolution to close a number of funds in fiscal year 2014-2015, approved on June 26, 2015, it was discovered the Hospital GOB Software Bond Fund had not been included in this resolution; and

WHEREAS: The final payment for the Hospital GOB Software Bond Fund was made on January 14, 2014; and

WHEREAS: It is the intent of the Rock County Board to close the Hospital GOB Software Bond Fund in the current fiscal year.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT

1. The Rock County Treasurer transfer \$39.04 from Hospital GOB Software Bond Fund near the end of the current fiscal year in order to close the Fund into the General Fund.
2. The Rock County Treasurer transfer any future funds received from the Hospital GOB Software Bond Fund into the General Fund.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-19

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was signed in to law on October 30, 2000, placing new emphasis on state and local mitigation planning for natural hazards and requiring communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared by Region 24 Emergency Management Agency, with assistance from JEO Consulting Group, Inc.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the mitigation plan was to lessen the effects of disasters by increasing the disaster resistance of the counties and participating jurisdictions located within the planning boundary by identifying the hazards that affect ROCK COUNTY and prioritize mitigation strategies to reduce potential loss of life and property damage from those hazards, and

WHEREAS, FEMA regulations require documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of ROCK COUNTY in the form of a resolution and further requesting approval of the plan at the Federal Level; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the governing body of ROCK COUNTY does herewith adopt the Region 24 Emergency Management Agency Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan 2021 in its entirety; and

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-20

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Emergency Management Act in Sections 81-829.36 to 81-829.75 R.R.S. Nebraska, as amended provides that the elected officials of local governments shall be responsible for ensuring that emergency management services are provided to their citizens, and;

WHEREAS, Section 81-829.46(2) R.R.S. Nebraska, as amended provides that each local government shall be within the jurisdiction of and served by the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency and shall participate in a city, village, county, or interjurisdictional emergency management organization, and;

WHEREAS, Section 81-829.46(3) R.R.S. Nebraska as amended provides that each county emergency management organization shall have either a full-time director or full-time deputy director appointed, and;

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that Rock County shall meet its statutory obligation by appointing a director to carry out the requirements of the Nebraska Emergency Management Act, and;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Board of Commissioners of the County of Rock, State of Nebraska, that the Board does hereby appoint Glen W. May, Deputy Emergency Management Director for Rock County, to serve as the Emergency Management Director for Rock County commencing July 1, 2021 to carry out the requirements of the Emergency Management Act for the citizens of Rock County, with the compensation and duties to be determined by the County Board, subject to the Board changing the appointment as determined in the sole discretion of the Board.
