

The Rock County Board of Commissioners meeting was advertised in the Rock County Leader on November 26, 2025. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hollenbeck at 1:00 p.m. as posted. Roll call was taken. Present were Commissioners Wade Hollenbeck, Faye Smith & Colby Sybrant. Also present were Waylon Reynolds, Road Foreman & Daunitta Buoy, Clerk.

Hollenbeck stated the Open Meeting Law is posted on the wall in the Commissioners room.

The minutes were presented to the Commissioners for the November 18, 2025 regular meeting, published November 26, 2025. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by Smith to approve the minutes for the November 18, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Roll Call Vote: Sybrant Yes – Smith – Yes Hollenbeck Abstained. Motion carried.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk’s office. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

W. Reynolds, Road Foreman gave road updates. Holes that need patched were discussed. An estimate was received from Frontier Diesel for work on the Western Star truck for \$10,972.04.

A Grant, NIRMA Representative met with the Commissioners to discuss NIRMA insurance policies and safety committee updates. The Commissioners discussed that the City hadn’t turned in a claim for previous damage in December, 2022 & February, 2024 to the ambulance barn. Faye & Ally visited in April, 2024 with the City about the damages & that they needed to turn a claim in.

Todd Thornton met with the Commissioners requesting a Subdivision in the SE4 of 9-30-19. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to approve the subdivision of a tract in the SE4 of Section 9, Township 30N, Range 19, W of the 6th P.M., Rock Co., NE. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against Motion carried.

TJ, Assessor/Zoning Administrator visited with the Commissioners on the updates on the Counties Zoning Comprehensive Plan.

Fee reports were presented to the Commissioners to review. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by Hollenbeck to approve the Clerk, Clerk of the District Court & Sheriff Fees. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against Motion carried.

Ben Shelbourn, Sheriff, Derek White, Chief Deputy & Trenton Gurnsey, Ambulance Representative met with the Commissioners on concerns that our insurance doesn’t cover their personal vehicles when responding to a call. After discussion....insurance follows the vehicle, not the driver.

Weed Superintendent Applications were reviewed. Applicants will be contacted & appointments will be set up for December 30, 2025.

Commissioners reviewed the completed 24/25 audit from the State Auditor. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by to approve the audit from the State Auditor’s office for 24/25. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.
