The Rock County Board of Commissioners meeting was advertised in the Rock County Leader on October 29, 2025. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hollenbeck at 1:00 p.m. as posted. Roll call was taken. Present were Commissioners Wade Hollenbeck, Faye Smith & Colby Sybrant. Also present were Waylon Reynolds, Road Foreman, Lloyd Smith, Highway Superintendent & Daunitta Buoy, Clerk.

Hollenbeck stated the Open Meeting Law is posted on the wall in the Commissioners room.

The minutes were presented to the Commissioners for the October 21, 2025 regular meeting, published October 29, 2025. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to approve the minutes for the October 21, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against.

The Commissioners are looking at adopting a policy where there will be a \$400 per half mile assessed to the land owners' real estate taxes if they don't mow their roads. Clerk presented the Commissioners with the Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent received from Nebraska Department of Transportation. Motion by Hollenbeck and seconded by Sybrant to approve Resolution 2025-15, Signing of the Year-End Certification of County Highway Superintendent. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

Mona Davis, Treasurer met with the Commissioners to report on the Distress Warrants for 2024 personal property taxes. There is around \$600.00 in personal property taxes that haven't been paid.

Jess Pozehl, Deputy Emergency Manager met with the Commissioners on the CWDG grant.
