

The Rock County Board of Commissioners meeting was advertised in the Rock County Leader on June 10, 2026. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hollenbeck at 9:00 a.m. as posted. Roll call was taken. Present were Commissioners Wade Hollenbeck, Faye Smith & Colby Sybrant. Also present were Joe Contreras/Building Grounds & Lisa Fales, Deputy Clerk.

Hollenbeck stated the Open Meeting Law is posted on the wall in the Commissioners room.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk’s office. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

The minutes were presented to the Commissioners for the May 26, 2026, morning road meeting & June 1, 2026 regular meeting, published June 10, 2026. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to approve the minutes for the May 26, 2026 morning road meeting minutes & June 1, 2026 regular meeting as presented. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. A dedication for the Carn’s bridge was discussed after the bridge is completed.

Road Department: Glen May was hired part time at \$20.00/HR still looking for a fulltime employee.

Scott Erthum, Weed Superintendent left a report with the Commissioners on CWDG Grant updates & weed spraying.

Road mowing and SRT will be addressed at the next meeting as our County Attorney was unavailable for this meeting.
