The Rock County Board of Commissioners meeting was advertised in the Rock County Leader on April 30, 2025. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hollenbeck at 9:00 a.m. as posted. Roll call was taken. Present were Commissioners Wade Hollenbeck, Faye Smith & Colby Sybrant. Also present were Waylon Reynolds, Road Foreman & Daunitta Buoy, Clerk.

Hollenbeck stated the Open Meeting Law is posted on the wall in the Commissioners room.

The minutes were presented to the Commissioners for the April 15, 2025 regular meeting, published April 22, 2025. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by Smith to approve the minutes for the April 15, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk’s office. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

April Fee Reports were presented to the Commissioners. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by Smith to approve the Clerk, Clerk of the District Court & Sheriff Fee Reports for April. Roll Call Vote: All For: None Against Motion carried.

W. Reynolds, Road Foreman gave road updates. Holiday pay was discussed. The handbook reads that holiday pay is paid out on normal days worked. The road crew doesn’t work on Fridays normally. Clerk sent out a request to the Clerk’s across the State. The majority of the Counties only pay 8 hours per Holiday regardless of the hours an employee usually works. Motion by Hollenbeck and seconded by Sybrant to only pay holidays to employees on days normally worked per the handbook. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against Motion Carried. Purchasing tires for the 644H Loader were discussed. Waylon received quotes from Triple R Tire for \$4825.00 & Rock County Tire for \$5300.00. Motion by Smith and seconded by Hollenbeck to accept the lowest bid for 2 Titan tires for the 644H Payloader from Triple R Tire’s quote for \$4825.00. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Discussion was held on dirt offered by Strelows. They will give the dirt to the County, but the County will be responsible for digging it. Waylon will check with contractors and get bids. Sealed bids for the 1983/8830 Ford Tractor were opened. 2 bids were received. \$8175.00 & \$6250.00. Motion by Hollenbeck and seconded by Sybrant to approve the bid for \$8175.00 from Marcus Becker. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against Motion carried. Waylon reported on the iWorq’s program progress.

Insurance Premiums from NACO were discussed for 25/26 budget year. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to keep the \$1600 deductible plan. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against Motion carried.
