

The Rock County Board of Commissioners meeting was advertised in the Rock County Leader on February 25, 2026. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hollenbeck at 1:00 p.m. as posted. Roll call was taken. Present were Commissioners Wade Hollenbeck, Faye Smith & Colby Sybrant. Also present were Cathy Doke, Rock County Leader & Daunitta Buoy, Clerk.

Hollenbeck stated the Open Meeting Law is posted on the wall in the Commissioners room.

The minutes were presented to the Commissioners for the February 17, 2026 regular meeting, published February 25, 2026. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by Smith to approve the minutes for the February 17, 2026 regular meeting as presented. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion by Smith and seconded by Sybrant to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk’s office. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

Stacey Knox, Bassett Chamber met with the Commissioners about Countywide clean up day to be held June 6, 2026. Motion by Hollenbeck and seconded by Sybrant to approve paying for 1 dumpster at Rose & Newport & the County/City split the dumpster cost for Bassett. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

Ally Grant met with the Commissioners on the ambulance claims for damage to the Ambulance Barn. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by Smith to approve the quote from Raynor for the door & JP Construction for the labor, for a total cost of \$2845.93. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried. Trenton Gurnsey & Kathleen Schaaf met with the Commissioners to discuss the excessive damage claims to the county for the Ambulance Department. The new ambulance is being housed at the airport.

Policies for Credit Cards & Meals were discussed. Motion by Smith and seconded by Hollenbeck to approve the policies for Credit Cards & Meals as presented. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried. The policies will be put in the employee handbook.

Motion by Hollenbeck and seconded by Sybrant to appoint Faye Smith as an alternate to the NCDC Board. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

February Fee Reports were presented to the Commissioners. Motion by Sybrant and seconded by Hollenbeck to approve the Clerk, Clerk of the District Court & Sheriff February Fee Reports. Roll Call Vote: All For None Against. Motion carried.

Kristin Olson, NCDC Director & Jessica Pozehl, Deputy Emergency Manager met with the Commissioners on the grant from the Department of Interior. The skid tanks that will be purchased with this grant money have to be dedicated to a VIN#, most of our rural trucks are owned by the Forestry Service. A waiver from the Forestry Service will need to be obtained before the skid tanks can be put on one of the Forestry trucks. Motion by Hollenbeck and seconded by Smith to have Rock County be the applicant for the grant from the Department of Interior for all of Rock County’s Fire Departments.

Bernie Hart, Rock County Airport Authority met with the Commissioners to discuss the County storing the signs, sign trailer & new ambulance at the Airport.
